### **Interment of Ashes Plot Pathway**

1. Plots to be 457.2 x 457.2 mm (18" x 18") *The Plot number assigned and referenced on this form is for administration purposes only. The next available plot space will be used at time of interment.*
2. Parishioners or Accustomed Members of Carrigaline Union of Parishes only may purchase exclusive rights of burial prior to the occasion of the first interment unless the Select Vestry vote to allow otherwise on an individual case basis.
3. No plot may be resold or transferred/bequeathed except by prior permission of the Select Vestry.
4. Interments shall take place only between the hours of 9 am and 5 pm Mondays to Fridays and 9am to 12 noon on Saturdays. In winter, burials must take place one hour earlier. All burial times shall be subject to the approval of the Rector. The burial order will begin at the South East corner of St Mary's Church and proceed westward as each burial occurs.
5. A maximum of two sets/caskets of ashes to be allowed in any one plot.
6. The undertaker must satisfy the Rector and Churchwardens that the legal requirements have been complied with so as to allow the burial to proceed
7. Fees\*
  - Exclusive Right of Interment of Ashes (457.2mm x 457.2 mm plot, up to 2 caskets/sets of ashes per plot): €500.00 (subscribing parishioners) and €700.00 (others)
  - Reopening of existing 'Interment of Ashes' plot: €100.00
  - Church Fee (not applicable to subscribing parishioners): €100.00*\*Note that these Fees are valid at Easter 2026 and may be adjusted annually in line with the Consumer Price Index.*
8. In accordance with the Constitution of the Church of Ireland, the permission of the Rector and Churchwardens must be obtained before any flagstone/flat stone be erected
  - All 'Interment of Ashes' plots must have specified flat stones made of Limestone, size 457.2 x 457.2 mm, laid level with no gap between adjacent stones.
  - In order to facilitate maintenance, no kerbing, railing or surround of any kind whatsoever shall be permitted.
  - No tree, bush or shrub may be planted on the ashes plot.
  - No glass jam jars or glass containers are permitted on any plot
  - No light or naked flames may be left unattended on any plot
  - Small plants may be left on plots, resting in moveable containers. Flowers, wreaths etc. shall be removed after a reasonable period, or when they become unsightly in the judgement of the Rector and Churchwardens

These regulations and fees, in addition to the adjustment with inflation, are to be reviewed from time to time by the Select Vestry or on directions of the Diocesan Council.
